When the world needs us, we're there — before, during and after an emergency.

- We have responded to **almost every global emergency** over the past 20 years and provided **\$4 billion in humanitarian assistance** since our founding.
- Our cash distributions during emergencies have infused more than \$300 million into local economies around the world.
- Mercy Corps is a leading responder to the Syria crisis. Our work reached more than 2.3 million people inside Syria in 2017.

Building a stronger tomorrow.

We create breakthrough solutions by connecting people to the resources they need to strengthen their community from within.

- We invest about **65 percent** of our program spending **on long-term solutions**. We have reached more than **3.5 million young people** since 2010.
- We provided over \$24 million in grants and loans to more than 41,000 entrepreneurs and small businesses around the world in 2017.
- In 2017, we connected more than 160,000 young people to resources that helped them overcome prolonged stress caused by conflict and disasters.
